- Link patients to establish a medical and dental home


SERVICES PROVIDED


- Emergency dental care to relieve patients' acute pain
- Dental supplies and oral hygiene instruction
- Hemoglobin A1c tests to assess for diabetes and provide nutritional counseling
- HIV screening and connect patient to ECU Infectious Disease if needed
- Interdisciplinary care: Connect patients from local shelters and medical clinics to HIP and then to to long term primary care or dental care using social work services
- Referral program from Vidant's Minor Emergency Department to ECU Dental School
- Patient Surveys to evaluate HIP program
